1. Background

In keeping with the DBSA facility management agenda and provision of excellent facilities services, the DBSA wishes to outsource a service provider that will provide laundry services who will ensure that there is quality and good workmanship to a desirable standard that is in line with industry practice. The service provider to provide the DBSA with laundry services for a period of 36 months.

1.1 Scope of Work

To provide laundry services to the DBSA such as dry Cleaning of all linen, washing, ironing and collection and delivery of material (i.e. tablecloths etc.) And any other related laundry services.

The Service should include the following:

- The quality of goods returned to be in an excellent condition, i.e. stains removed, ironed well or tumble-dried with no creasing, fully dried before returning.
- Dry cleaning of all fabrics to comply with common and or standard dry-cleaning instructions.
- Goods to be picked up and dropped off within 3 4 days.
- Goods to be weighed on collection, service provider to provide a scale for the services.
- Collection and delivery notes to be issued and signed.
- Invoice to be issued based on weight of goods collected.
- Estimated volumes +/- 650 kg per month.
- Signed delivery notes to be attached with invoices for payment.
- Service provider will be responsible for collecting and delivering of laundry as per agreed times with DBSA.


